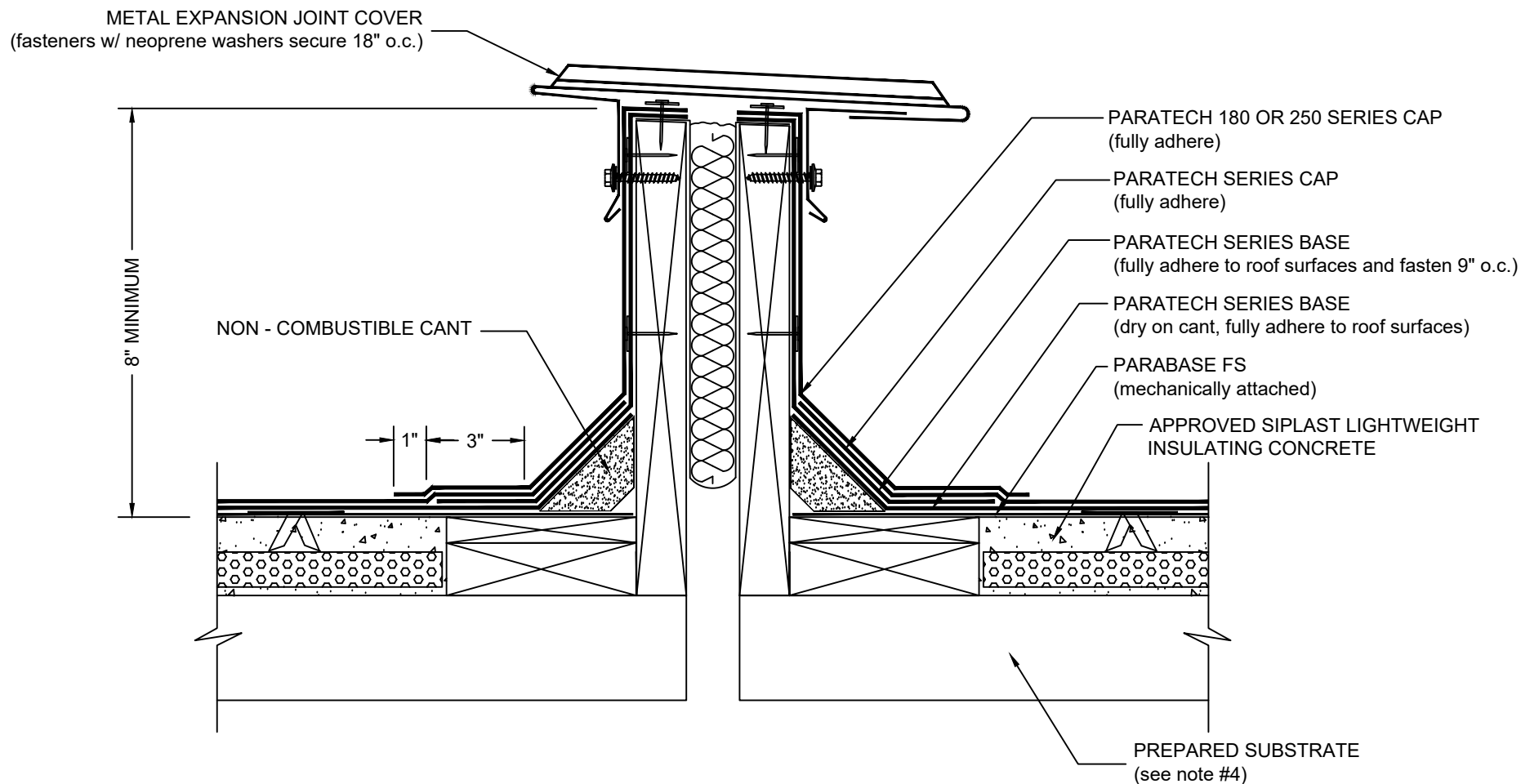


EXPANSION JOINT (ROOF TO ROOF)

PARATECH - SIPLAST LIGHTWEIGHT INSULATING CONCRETE



NOTES:

1. THE CARPENTRY AND METAL WORK SHOWN DEPICTS SHOP FABRICATION AND JOB-SITE ASSEMBLY. THESE COMPONENTS SHOULD BE DESIGNED/FABRICATED/INSTALLED ACCORDING TO GENERALLY ACCEPTED INDUSTRY PRACTICES, STANDARDS, AND APPROVALS.
2. DISSIMILAR METAL TYPES SUBJECT TO ELECTROLYTIC REACTION SHOULD BE PHYSICALLY SEPARATED.
3. REQUIREMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS DETAILED IN SIPLAST SPECIFICATIONS SHALL APPLY IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE DRAWING.
4. REFERENCE THE SIPLAST TECHNICAL GUIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATE SIPLAST LIGHTWEIGHT INSULATING CONCRETE SYSTEM WITH REGARD TO SPECIFIC SUBSTRATE TYPES.
